There are 172 full-time teaching staff members (97 professors) for the 1,868-person undergraduate capacity. This complies with the legal standard (97 teaching staff members, with 53 of them being professors, required). There are 313 research advisors (207 professors) and 36 assistant research advisors for the 663-person graduate student capacity. This complies with the legal standard (55 research advisors, with 40 of them being professors, and 14 assistant research advisors required).
